**This Far By Faith: Twenty Years of Cass Community
Book Launch and Ambassadors' Tour**

September 27th Event to Benefit Nonprofit Organization

(August 12, 2014 – Detroit, Mi.)... On **Saturday, September 27, 2014 at 1PM, Cass Community Publishing House (CCPH)** will celebrate its first publication: “[This Far By Faith: Twenty Years of Cass Community](#),” written by Rev. Faith Fowler, at Detroit’s **Orchestra Hall**. Fowler is also the Executive Director of Cass Community Social Services and CCPH Publisher.

Tickets are on sale now for the special September 27th book launch event at Orchestra Hall, and include a complimentary, autographed copy of the book. “This Far By Faith: Twenty Years of Cass Community” is a collection of short stories highlighting Cass Community Social Services’ (Cass) work with hungry, homeless, sick and unemployed people. The anecdotes also address the organization’s growth, changes in Detroit and the impact of technology and globalization. The short stories are peppered with humor.

Rev. Fowler and other community leaders will read excerpts from the book and musical group, the Cass Ambassadors, will entertain patrons. For the inaugural event (only), the talented singing group made up of formerly homeless men will be joined by choir members from the Cass United Methodist Church to sing “We’ve Come This Far By Faith,” an African-American hymn and the inspiration for the book’s title.

Beginning **Sunday, September 28, 2014**, Rev. Fowler and the Ambassadors will begin a week long, statewide tour. All events begin at 7 P.M. (the Gaylord event will begin at 6 P.M.) and have no admission fee. Books and Green Industry products will be available for purchase. The profits from the book sales benefit the work of Cass Community Social Services. The upcoming dates and locations are as follows:
